Maths:

Counting to 5

Literacy:

To learn sounds like "S, A, T" and to be able to blend the sounds into a word.
To understand that every sentence needs a capital letter and full stop.
To be able to read to children every day.

Knowledge and Understanding:

Children to understand the 5 senses and to understand that there are 4 seasons in a year. To have a wide discussion about weather changes and what we expect the weather to be like.

Reception: In school, we are covering...

Expressive Arts and Design – Mark making, cutting, gluing and sticking.

Physical Education – Introduction to PE and Dance

Music – Nursery Rhymes

PSHE - Being me in the world, to express feelings, seeing similarities and differences.
